Match Format

The match will be a Tournament level match. Scores will be posted on the Match Web Site (www.uspsa-area6.org) at the end of each day. Final match results will be posted on the Match web page, as well as on the USPSA web site (www.uspsa.org).

Squadding Information

You will have a choice on a first come, first serve basis of squadding times. You can choose to shoot the match all in one day on Friday, all in one day on Saturday, or split the match over two days and shoot Saturday Morning / Sunday Morning, or Saturday Afternoon / Sunday Morning. Some all day Saturday slots will be reserved for those people volunteering to be Friday ROs.

We will still use on-line squadding to allow shooters to adjust their squadding.

We will fill any squad requests you submit with your application if we can do so at the time we enter your registration data into the system. This means we will put you directly in a all day SAT slot if you ask and we have one open, and will even put you into squads with people you request.

Once we enter your registration data on-line, your initial squadding data will be available and you may change it using the web based system.

There are a few limitations to this system:

Limitation #1: We will not re-arrange existing squads. If you ask to be squadded with Bill and Bob, and they are already in different squads, we will not move one of them to fit you three together. You, Bill and Bob are, however, welcome to do that yourself with the on-line squadding system.

Limitation #2: We will not "hold openings" in slots for future arrivals. Requests such as "save an opening in this squad and put Joe in it if he signs up" will not be tracked.

Limitation #3: We will not track "forward looking requests" which cannot be processed at the time we are entering your registration data. These are requests like "squad me with Joe Blow who is sending in his registration separately".

Limitation #4: If a shooter has requested a "private registration", they do not exist on the squadding matrix when processing competitor requests. If you ask to be squadded with Ms. Famous, and Ms. Famous has requested her name be kept off the public registration list, don't expect us to squad you with her unless Ms. Famous has given us permission to honor this request.

Awards

The amount of each award and the number of awards per class will be solely contingent on the overall number of paying shooters and the number of paying shooters per class.

A competitor may receive all trophies, which he or she merits, however a competitor is entitled to only one (1) money award. For instance, if a competitor places first A Limited and High Senior champion, he would receive the higher of the two cash prizes, but not both. The cash not awarded because of multiple winners will be returned to the pool for all prizes in that division. The total amount of cash awards for each division will be based upon the number of competitors in that division. It is likely that a class winner in one division may receive more than the same class winner for another division.

All class and category winners, as well as division winners, will receive a plaque, in addition to the money award. All awards of money will be made in the 5 Divisions (Open, Limited, L10, Production and Revolver) as listed in the match booklet.

Shooter's Barbeque

We will host a shooter's barbeque after shooting concludes on Friday night and Saturday night for competitors and staff. There will be no charge for competitors and extra tickets will be available at the match for guests and children. Please join us!

Ammo and other Special Requirements

See Match Booklet for specifics. The round count for the match will be between 250-300 rounds.

Match Host Hotel

We have two hotels in Conyers off of I-20 East that have blocks of rooms for our match. Please use the code 'Area 6' to get the discounted rate. The LaQuinta Hotel (770-918-0092) has a rate of \$82 for doubles and \$92 for kings. The Hampton Inn (877-204-5825) has double rooms for \$79. Both hotels are approximately 15 miles from the range and have hot breakfasts each morning. The blocks of rooms will be released on 4/15/06. One exit down from these hotels is the Holiday Inn (770-483-3220) where we have stayed in the past. We don't have a special rate there, but it is around \$65-\$70 per night. Other hotels in the area will be about the same distance from the range and there are good restaurants nearby.

We have one hotel in McDonough that is a favorite of some of our folks that come up from I-75 South. The Best Inn (770-957-5821) has agreed to give us double rooms for \$36 per night. The code for this hotel is 'Area 6'. There are some good restaurants nearby, but not as many as in Conyers. It is about the same distance from the range as Conyers.

2006 Area 6 ROs & Staff

The 2006 Area 6 Championship Match needs the help of volunteers who will donate their time, skills and effort to make the match fair, safe and fun for the shooters.

New this year! Each RO will receive a per diem of \$50 for each day worked during the Area 6. This can be used for paying your hotel room and for buying your lunch on match days.

Wanted: Friday ROs or CROs

We would like to offer an opportunity to any RO or CRO who would be willing to work Friday, then shoot the match on Saturday and Sunday with a squad. We will hold a few Saturday only slots for our Friday ROs. **Friday** only staff will pay only \$75 for the entry fee for the match. Staff shooters are eligible for all the prizes and awards available to any other competitor.

Staff will receive a \$50 per diem for each day worked to cover any hotel and lunch expense. Water and soft drinks will be available to you in the staff trailer during the match.

If you are interested in helping, check the appropriate blank on the application to indicate you want to be a Friday RO.

Friday RO's and staff need to report to the range by 7:30am on Friday, May 5th.

Wanted: Saturday/Sunday ROs or CROs and Other Staff

Staff members who work Saturday and Sunday will shoot for free on Friday. Staff shooters are eligible for all the prizes and awards available to any other competitor. Saturday/Sunday staff will receive a free match Polo shirt.

Staff will receive a \$50 per diem for each day worked to cover any hotel and lunch expense. Water and soft drinks will be available to you in the staff trailer during the match.

If you are interested in helping, check the appropriate blank on the application to indicate you want to work as an RO or CRO. Do not send in any fees with your application, but be sure to indicate your shirt size.

Saturday/Sunday RO's and staff need to report to the range by 7:00am on Saturday, May 6th and Sunday, May 7th.
